 - CRADA between DOE NETL and Gassnova
 - Modelling and data collection at TCM
- SINTEF (Tiller), cooperation with several US companies
- Common calls through ACT
- US-Norway industry development





Status ACT calls with US

2nd ACT call for proposals

Funding agencies from 11 countries

12 new projects decided for funding in 2019

7 (7) with US (and Norway)

USA and France included as new countries

31 M€ from ACT

3rd ACT call for proposals

Funding agencies from 15 countries

13 new projects decided for funding in 2021

6 (3) with US (and Norway)

India, Canada, Denmark and Italy included as new countries

30 M€ from ACT

4th ACT call for proposals

Funding agencies from 5 countries, both US and Norway

14 M€ from ACT

Deadline 12th September 2022
