What is an ERA-NET Cofund ?




- Several Member states in a consortium (ministries/funding agencies) establishing one or several common calls with top up financing from EC
 - EC finances 50% of the MS total budget.
- Focus on demonstrating and validating solutions.

Total budget for projects, 1st call: 41.2 M€


Canada, US, Italy and France have showed interest in ACT, yet none of these have joined as partners

Challenges

- Getting industry interested
- R&D institutions to respond to industry needs
- Address questions that are of national value, but also of international interest
- The call text not too narrow, not too broad, but broad enough to fit "all sizes" (countries in ACT)
 - All areas of CCUS covered

New ACT projects

- 8 projects have been offered funding from ACT
- Contract negotiations ongoing
- The new projects will be kicked off Sep 2017
- In total: 36 M € from ACT
- 3 large projects (5-14 M€ in funding from ACT)
 - Full chain CCUS by combining pilots all over Europe
 - CCS combined with Hydrogen
 - Handling pressure build-up during CO₂-injection
- 5 smaller projects (1-2 M€ from ACT)
 - Design full scale CCUS for Northern Europe
 - CO₂ storage Risk assessment and mitigation measures
 - Novel reactor technology for CO₂ capture
 - CO₂ EOR concept for South-East Europe
 - 3D printed CO₂ capture materials

- Alignment with European CCS RD&D activities outside ACT
- Collaboration with European CCS initiatives, through common workshops
- Strengthen R&D collaboration with key stakeholders outside Europe
- Closer cooperation with the energy sector and industry
- New common call in 2018
- Knowledge gained from ACT and ACT projects will be shared
